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INTRODUCTION TO PROJECT

Community is what schools are built around, and the community here in Bloomingdale that has been built around Dujardin Elementary School has the best teachers, families and businesses. With that being said, The Dujardin Elementary School playground deserves the best and is in need of an overhaul. We are looking forward to include a **new wheel-chair accessible section to accommodate our special needs children as well as new equipment for a portion of the playground, concrete work, poured in place (PIP) surface and new drainage system** to complete the newly improved Dujardin Jaguar playground!

We are also hoping to provide this all-accessible playground to those children located at Marklund homes (property adjacent to Dujardin School Playground). We are seeking the help of the Bloomingdale Education Foundation, government grants, local businesses, and the community to help raise funds to rebuild the Dujardin playground, known as **“Playground Fun for Everyone”**.

The newly renovated playground project at Dujardin School will provide recreational opportunities to individuals with disabilities and “at risk” early childhood students who require special assistance in order to participate in recreation. Although the existing playground, which was established in the early 1990’s, has adequate equipment for most students it does not promote the vision of **“Playground Fun for Everyone.”** The playground will also be available for use by clientele of the **Marklund Home** (This is a pediatric-skilled nursing facility for infants and children, with a comprehensive active treatment program which provides for the intensive medical, social, emotional and physical needs of their residents.). Marklund Home is located adjacent to the Dujardin School playground. The potential for community use is limitless and once the project is complete the playground will meet the needs of toddlers up through fitness minded adults.

During Dujardin’s 2009-2010 school year, the existing **playground serviced 370 students of which 20 students have profound physical disabilities and an additional 20 students were enrolled in the “at risk” early childhood program which is for students with developmental delays.**

At Marklund Home, there are currently over 20 full-time residents and 40 day-time children who will have access to this playground.



INTRODUCTION TO PROJECT

The Bloomingdale School District 13 Education Foundation is a non-profit, independent tax-exempt corporation, founded in 1998, created to provide special opportunities and experiences for the children and staff of our district. Based on the current economic climate within the State of Illinois and our projected long-term needs, the community cannot rely solely on traditional funding to ensure quality public education. The Bloomingdale Education Foundation is developing and launching short and long-term project plan to assist in supporting our educators and District 13 projects. The goal of this project plan is to support the Dujardin playground project renovation, "Playground Fun For Everyone" with plans to help raise and channel donations for creative and innovated endeavours that benefit our students. We hope to achieve this through, grants, fund-raising and sponsorships:

GRANTS

The need for increasing the Bloomingdale Education Foundation fund-raising efforts has become a major goal for 2010-2013. The Bloomingdale Education Foundation has currently relied on several low revenue producing events throughout the years and now has a need for additional volunteers and financial support. The Dujardin's "Playground Fun For Everyone" project is estimated at \$250,000. We are requesting \$150,000 in grant support to help us achieve completion of this project.

FUND-RAISING

We will be asking the community for their help as well through many fund-raisers throughout the year to help raise the necessary funds we need. Our upcoming events to name a few are "Back to School BBQ" - August 26th, Jog-A-Thon - September 30th, Pancake Breakfast, Snowflake festival... All profits from these events will go directly to the "Playground Fun For Everyone" fund. Besides coming to support these events please let us know if you can help by other means such as donating food, merchandise/gift cards for raffles or auctions, or your time. We know that every little bit helps and greatly appreciate any support families, friends and businesses can provide us with.

PLAYGROUND GOAL AND BUDGET

This is a project to reconstruct and renovate the playground area at Dujardin School in Bloomingdale, IL District 13

The focus of this project is to make a significant portion of the existing playground ADA compliant and readily available for all students and the community. This will include grading the entire playground area so that adequate drainage of rain water takes place. At this time water puddles around the existing equipment and makes the area unusable for days after it rains. Also included will be constructing a “poured in place” surface that will allow wheel chair access. Currently the area is filled with wood chips and is not wheel chair accessible. The final stage includes installing an ADA accessible ramp system that will include ground level equipment (see playground layout).
