Dear Parents and Guardians,

As many of you are aware, there are several movements underway to have students walk out of schools to encourage Congress to enact new gun control legislation. As of today, there are two dates identified for the walk-outs, March 14th and April 20th at 10:00 a.m. While we applaud and respect a child's desire to make a difference and take a stand for what they believe in, we cannot let the students walk out of the schools on these days because of the impact on student safety.

I'm sure we can all agree that the safety of children should be a top priority for our nation. It is because of our commitment to student safety, that we cannot allow children to leave the school during the school day without adult supervision. District 13 staff members will be inside each of the buildings, engaged in their teaching responsibilities and duties. A walk out would compromise our ability to maintain the safety of each and every child.

At the same time, these events offer unique learning opportunities for those students that are capable of comprehending these complex issues. District staff members are considering available options for those students that feel the need to connect to the issues without putting them potentially in harm's way. Once any of these learning opportunities have been developed, they will be shared through the weekly newsletter of the school your child attends.

We are asking for your support in communicating with your children, as I know we share the same goal of keeping your children safe.

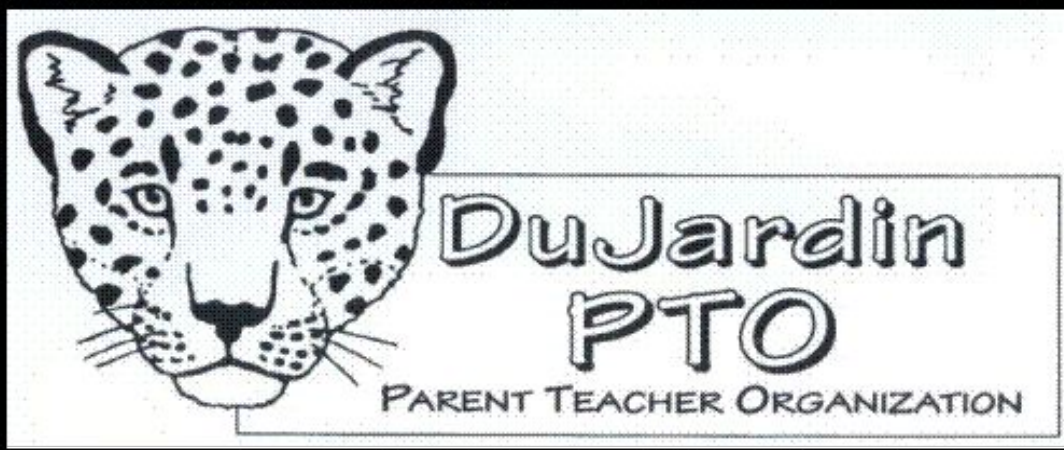
